Data Protection

Campden Charities takes the confidentiality of personal data seriously. We comply with the principles of The General Data Protection Regulations May 2018. This means that any personal data collected by Campden Charities is used in accordance with GDPR May 2018. You have the right to object to your personal data being processed. However, the Charities' legitimate reasons for processing your information is in order to provide financial assistance, objection will mean requests will be withdrawn.

Personal information provided to the Charities will be used for the purposes outlined at the time of collection and will be retained for as long as the Charities has a lawful purpose to do so:

- Assess eligibility of household members to receive grants and financial support from the Charities
- Track contact and progress with beneficiaries
- To continue to determine appropriate support

In addition, personal information may be used for statistical analysis of the Charities' grant making programmes.

Your personal details will not be made available to any third parties unless this has been explicitly outlined in the data protection section of the initial assessment form.

Consent

Your consent to process your personal data will form part of the Charities' on-going relationship with you. This privacy notice and other methods of seeking your consent is under constant review.
